## **REGISTRATION AT ST. JOE'S**

Without proper registration the pastor and parish does not have full faculties to address many sacramental, official and legal and charitable needs. Parish registration is NOT OPTIONAL, and it shows lack of serious attitude. "I come to church/mass" is not enough to establish a proper membership at St. Joe's, or elsewhere for that matter. There will be no exceptions to that rule! Those households who have not been active for 6 months or more will receive a letter from the pastor informing them that are no longer members of St. Joseph Church Community.
