REGISTRATION AT ST. JOE'S

Those who would like to register at our church, must fill out a form that is available at stjjamaica.org/registration. After the registration, the pastor will contact the household over the phone. We remind you that **it takes 3 months of residence until the registration is in full effect**. Without proper registration the pastor and parish do not have full faculties to address many sacramental, official, legal and charitable needs. **Parish registration is NOT OPTIONAL**, and it shows lack of serious attitude. "I come to church/mass" is not enough to establish a proper membership at St. Joe's, or elsewhere for that matter. **There will be no exceptions to that rule!** Those households who have not been active for 6 months or more will receive a letter from the pastor informing them that are no longer members of St. Joseph Church Community.

ASH WEDNESDAY

On **Wednesday, March 5**, we will begin the season of Lent. There will be Mass said that day **in English at 6:30 PM**. This is not a holy day of obligation

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

We invite you join us as we are celebrating the Stations of the Cross **every Friday of Lent at 7:00 PM** in English.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday (March 5) and on all the Fridays of the Lenten Season.

FASTING: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday (April 18) by limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken at two other occasions during the day.

EASTER DUTY: After having been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, the faithful are obligated to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, this precept to be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless it is fulfilled at some other time for a good reason. In the United States the period for fulfilling this precept is extended from the First Sunday of Lent (March 9) until Pentecost Sunday (June 8).

SUNDAY, MARCH 9TH: DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME BEGINS

We remind our Parishioners about the Daylight Savings Time, which will begin on Sunday, March 9th: it means that **we will sleep one hour less!**



MARCH 19—FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH

This coming month on Wednesday, March 19, the Church will celebrate a solemnity of St. Joseph, the husband of Mary, who is the patron saint of our church. **Bilingual Mass** at that day will be at **7:00PM**.
